STIEGER TAKES OVER LEAD IN RIVERSDALE CUP

New South Welshman Matthew Stieger took over the lead of the international amateur championship Riversdale Cup at Riversdale in Melbourne today with a 68 to be nine under the card.

He moved two shots clear of overnight leader Nathan Holman, of Victoria, who could not match his equal-course record opening round of 62.

Holman came home with 74 to be tied in second place on 137 with New Zealand's Fraser Wilkin (-3 today) and Brett Drewitt, of NSW (-4).

The in-form 2011 Tasmanian Open Champion Stieger birdied six holes in his round of 68 to top the leaderboard on 135.

His four under par round was the equal best of the day, being shared with Drewitt, who eagled the par five 6th hole, and New Zealanders Ryan Fox, Ben Campbell and Brad Kendall.

The New Zealanders are tied for 7th spot on the leader board at 140, one stroke behind West Australian Brady Watt, who also registered an eagle in his 69 to be in outright 6th position on 139.

Victoria's Todd Sinnott is in outright fifth spot on 138 with a round of 71 today.
