2012 RIVERSDALE CUP - CONDITIONS

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 Eligible players are male amateurs whose Australian Handicap at the time of entry does not exceed 3.4 strokes in accordance with the Australian Handicapping System unless otherwise exempt as per condition 1.5.
- 1.2 The field for the Riversdale Cup will be limited to 156 male players.
- 1.3 The 117th Riversdale Cup will be played over 72-holes stroke play consisting of 18 holes on each of Thursday February 16th; Friday February 17th; Saturday February 18th and Sunday February 19th.
- 1.4 The leading 50 male players plus ties plus nominated players part of State and International teams after 36-holes, will qualify to play in Rounds 3 & 4 of the 117th Riversdale Cup. Note: It is the responsibility of all competitors to ascertain their starting times for Day 3 – seeded draw – and the final day by logging onto Riversdale's web site www.riversdalegolf.com.au.
- 1.5 A maximum total of 132 players will be exempted into the starting field in order of priority in accordance with the following exemption categories:
 - a. Players exempted by the Riversdale Golf Club Match Committee (maximum of 8)
 - b. Current Golf Australia Squad members
 - c. Member of any Australian State or International invited Two Man Team
 - d. Any current member of a State or Junior Team (ie: competed in the 2011 Interstate Series)
 - e. Players nominated by national golf associations (maximum 4 per country)
 - f. Leading 30 players in the previous year's Ivo Whitton Trophy
 - g. Top 50 ranked players in the Australian Men's Amateur Ranking System at close of entry;
 - h. Leading 200 players from the Men's World Amateur Golf Ranking system (R&A) at close of entry;
 - i. Past Riversdale Cup Champions (handicap limit 3.4 applies)
 - j. 2011 Riversdale Cup top 25 finishers plus ties
 - k. Amateur players that competed in all Championship rounds of the 2012 Men's Victorian Open
 - l. Australian Men's Amateur Championship 2012 – Match Play Qualifiers
 - m. Victorian Amateur Championship 2011 – Match Play Qualifiers
 - n. Current championship holders, as at the close of entries, of the following Victorian Championships/titles: 2011 Country Championship, 2011 Junior Amateur Championship, 2012 Victorian Junior Masters, 2011 Geoff Ogilvy Trophy
 - o. Current Victorian Country Districts Men's Champion and the Victorian Golf League Open Men's Champion (handicap limit 3.4 applies)
 - p. Leading 10 players in the previous year's Averages Trophy (or equivalent) from each other Australian State;

Note: Should the maximum total of 132 exempt players be exceeded within an exemption category, the exempt players will be determined on the basis of those with the lowest Australian Handicaps. All other players not exempt from that category and any subsequent category shall be allocated a position in the pre-qualifying event subject to condition 1.6.

- 1.6 All remaining positions in the 117th Riversdale Cup will be filled via a pre-qualifying event to be held on Monday, 13th February 2012. A minimum number of 24 positions in the Championship field will be available at the pre-qualifying event. Entries to the pre-qualifying event will be accepted on the basis of handicap with the exception that in the event of entries exceeding field size capacity, a ballot will be undertaken with players on the highest handicaps as at the close of entry subject to elimination.
- 1.7 The leading player shall be the 2012 Riversdale Cup Champion and receive a trophy. In the event of a tie, a hole by hole play-off will be conducted on the 18th (or as otherwise decided by the Championship Committee), players who have tied being eliminated as they fail to maintain equality. In the event of a tie for runners-up not determined by the above play-off, the count back method recommended by Golf Australia will be used. The runner-up shall also receive a trophy.
- 1.8 Trophies will also be awarded to the leading two-man State or International Team after 72-holes and the player(s) with the lowest stroke score for each individual round of the Championship. In the event of a tie for such trophies, the count back method recommended by Golf Australia will be used.

2. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

- 2.1 The Championship Committee shall consist of the Riversdale Golf Club Match Committee, General Manager and two representatives from Golf Victoria.
- 2.2 In the absence of the full Championship Committee, such members thereof as may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Championship Committee. The Championship Committee reserves the right to vary any condition of this event.

In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, the Championship Committee may shorten the competition, appoint another day or days for completion of, or may transfer play to another course. Protests must be made to the Championship Committee not later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of each day's play except on the final day when they must be made within 5 minutes of the conclusion of play. The decision of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters relating to the Riversdale Cup.

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1 Entries will be restricted to amateurs, who are members of clubs affiliated with Golf Victoria, or of golf clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by this Association, or of clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League and Registered Golfers.
- 3.2 Entries must be made online or on the attached form to the General Manager, Riversdale Golf Club, PO Box 2368, Mt Waverley 3149 not later than 5pm Wednesday, 25 January 2012.
- 3.3 Entrance Fee MUST be paid at time of entry and includes complimentary practice range balls, pull buggies and snacks and drinks on course.
- 3.4 Entries must be accompanied by either the player's GolfLink Number or a copy of the entrant's current handicap record, officially endorsed by the Home Club.
- 3.5 All entries shall be subject to the approval of the Championship Committee who reserve the right to accept or refuse any entry without giving any reason for the decision which shall be final
- 3.6 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Championship Committee. Any such entry shall be subject to the application of a \$27.50 late fee (includes GST). Where the player nominates to pay the entry fee by credit card, by providing their credit card details, the card holder additionally authorises Riversdale Golf Club to debit the nominated account for the sum of the late entry fee (if applicable). Where payment is made by cheque, money order or cash, the player will be invoiced for the amount of the late entry fee and the entry will not be accepted until the full requisite payment has been received.

4. RULES

The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, the Golf Australia Hard Card and any other local rules as are in force on the course over which the competition rounds are being played. If any dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Championship Committee whose decision shall be final. In addition, all players are required to adhere to the Golf Australia Code of Conduct for the duration of the Championship. It should be noted that players will be subject to disqualification for a breach of etiquette in accordance with Rule of Golf 33-7.

5. DRAW AND STARTING TIMES

5.1 All draws will be made by the Championship Committee. The draw for the 1st and 2nd rounds of the Riversdale Cup (two-tee starts am/pm) will be available via both the Riversdale Golf Club Website and the Golf Victoria Website (www.golfvic.org.au) on the evening of Monday February 13th, 2012 following the completion of the pre-qualifying event.

5.2 The Championship Committee has the power to amend the draw or substitute another player for any competitor who is not at the tee at the time appointed to play. It may also alter the starting time for any player. However, it is a condition of the competition that, in absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole in stroke play instead of disqualification.

Note: Competitors must report to the Officials at the registration area at least 30 minutes before the notified time of starting.

6. HONORARY MEMBERS

Competitors will be made Honorary Members of the Riversdale Golf Club for the duration of their involvement in the 117th Riversdale Cup.

7. DRESS STANDARDS

Players and caddies must observe the Riversdale Golf Club dress standards that will be posted with the draw. Copies are also available upon request.

8. GOLF FOOTWEAR

All players are required to wear golf footwear in accordance with Riversdale Golf Club policy. Accordingly, no player is permitted to wear shoes with metal or traditionally designed spikes. Penalty: disqualification. Note: Refunds will not be given for non-compliance of this condition.

9. PRACTICE

Course facilities may be available for practice, on application at the professional shop from Monday 6th February to Thursday 9th February and after 1pm on Monday 13th February.

10. PACE OF PLAY

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

11. CONFORMING GOLF BALLS & CONFORMING DRIVER HEADS

The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls & Conforming Driver Heads.

12. DRUG TESTING

All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA. A list of the prohibited substances will be available at registration. Clarification of any medication can be obtained via ASADA Hotline- 1800 020 506, or from www.asada.gov.au.

13. CODE OF CONDUCT

All entrants are bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct ("the Code"). A copy of the Code is available at www.golfaustralia.org.au. Any breach of the Code may be recorded on the Central Register of the Code ("the Register").

14. MOTORISED TRANSPORT

During play, it is prohibited for a player or his caddie to ride in or on a motorised vehicle unless specific written permission has been granted by the Championship Committee. Penalty: 2 strokes for each hole at which a breach occurred; maximum penalty per round – 4 strokes. Procedure when breach discovered: Use of any unauthorised form or transportation must be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. Otherwise the player is disqualified.

Exception: - Rules Officials or a Championship Committee member may utilise mechanical locomotion to transport a player/caddie in the interests of pace of play where necessary (including during a sudden death play-off) without penalty.

Any player or caddie seeking authorisation to use a golf cart due to a disability as defined under the Disability Discrimination Act 1992 should contact Riversdale Golf Club to obtain information on procedures for submitting such requests. All such requests and required information must be submitted to Riversdale Golf Club simultaneously and together with the entry form (or within 2 days of the on-line entry being receipted).

Requests due to temporary injuries or impairments that do not qualify as a permanent disability under the Act will not be granted. In the event of a change in a medical condition after submitting the entry form but before the commencement of the event, written submission of all documentation must be received by Riversdale Golf Club no later than 7 days prior to the first day of the event. Riversdale Golf Club will consider any such request in accordance with these conditions and its rules, regulations and policies.

CONDITIONS FOR AUSTRALIAN MEN'S AMATEUR FOURSOME

1. FORMAT

1.1 The Championship shall be decided over 36 holes of Foursome stroke play on Tuesday, 14 February 2012.

1.2 The order of play from the tee must be changed for the 2nd Round.

1.3 In the event of a tie, joint winners shall be declared.

1.4 The winners shall be the Australian Men's Amateur Foursome Golf Champions and receive silver medallions. The runners-up shall receive bronze medallions.

1.5 The Online Entrance Fee is \$60.00 per pair (includes GST). Paper Entries \$100 per pair (inc GST)

2. CHAMPIONSHIP PLAY COMMITTEE

2.1 The Championship Play Committee will comprise the Chair of the Golf Australia Championships Committee, Golf Australia's Director - Championships, and Manager – Championships.

2.2 In the absence of the full Championship Play Committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision and any decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Play Committee.

- 2.3 The Championship Play Committee shall have the sole management and control of the Championship with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the conditions.
- 2.4 The Championship Play Committee's decision on matters affecting the Championship shall be final.
- 3. RULES OF PLAY**
The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Ltd, shall apply together with Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Play Committee.
- 4. ENTRIES**
- 4.1 Entries shall only be made either online or on the Entry Form issued by Golf Australia and The Riversdale Golf Club. Entry by email is acceptable provided it is a scanned image of the official entry form.
- 4.2 Eligible players are male amateur golfers whose individual Australian Handicap does not exceed 3.4 Strokes, or who are past winners of the Australian Men's Amateur Foursome Championship, or who are members of International teams for the Riversdale Cup, or Interstate teams for the Riversdale Cup.
- 4.3 Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by R & A Rules Ltd.
- 4.4 Entries shall be subject to approval from the Committee of an entrant's Home Club. (NB. This requirement may be waived in exceptional circumstances by the Championship Play Committee).
- 4.5 In the event of applications exceeding the number of places available in the Championship, entries from those pairs with higher handicap aggregates shall be decided by a handicap ballot. (NB the following shall be exempt from a handicap ballot: past winners of the Australian Amateur Foursome Championship, members of International teams for the Riversdale Cup, members of Interstate teams for the Riversdale Cup, pairs exempted by the Championship Play Committee.) Unsuccessful pairs shall be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Entrance fees will be refunded to pairs balloted out, who do not compete.
- 4.6 Fully completed Entry Forms must be received by the General Manager of Riversdale Golf Club by not later than 5.00pm Wednesday, 25 January 2012. It is the sole responsibility of the pair to ensure that its entry is received prior to the closing time for entries.
- 4.7 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Championship Match Committee. Any such entry shall be subject to the application of a \$27.50 late fee (includes GST).
- 4.8 In the event that an entry is received after the closing time for entries and that it is accepted, the pair shall be automatically liable to Riversdale Golf Club for the sum of \$27.50 (the "late entry fee" includes GST). Where the pair nominates to pay the entry fee by credit card, by providing their credit card details, the card holder additionally authorises Riversdale Golf Club to debit the nominated account for the sum of the late entry fee (if applicable). Where payment is made by cheque, money order or cash, the pair will be invoiced for the amount of the late entry fee and the entry will not be accepted until the full requisite payment has been received.
- 4.9 Acceptable payment methods are as follows credit card (Visa or MasterCard Only), cheque (personal or bank), money order, cash (please note though that Riversdale Golf Club will NOT accept responsibility for cash sent that is not received). Cheques or money orders are to be made payable to Riversdale Golf Club.
- 4.10 Entries will not be accepted by telephone or facsimile (exception entries with credit card payments only may be sent by facsimile), or unless the Entry Form is fully completed and signed by the secretary/manager of each entrant's home club.
- 4.11 Entrance Fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the closing time for entries, except for those pairs who may be balloted out and who do not subsequently compete.
- 4.12 For each player, an entry must be accompanied either by a copy of his current handicap record for the past six months officially endorsed by his home club, or by his GOLF Link number. A decision of the Championship Play Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry shall be final.
- 5. MEDIA**
All rights for televising live, television recordings, or for any visual or electronic reproduction of the Championship are reserved only to Golf Australia and may only be made under licence.
- 6. CONFORMING GOLF BALLS, CONFORMING DRIVER HEADS, AND TIME OF STARTING**
The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, and Time of Starting.
- 7. DRUG TESTING**
All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA. A list of the prohibited substances will be available at registration. Clarification of any medication can be obtained via ASADA Hotline- 1800 020 506, or from www.asada.gov.au.
- 8. CODE OF CONDUCT**
All entrants are bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct ("the Code"). A copy of the Code is available at www.golfaustralia.org.au. Any breach of the Code may be recorded on the Central Register of the Code ("the Register"). The Register may be accessed (and published from time to time) by any State Association or GA for the purposes of administering Competitions or state championships, events, competitions, practice sessions or major activities conducted or sanctioned by a State Association, or any State Association or GA codes of conduct and/or other related matters.
- 9. PRACTICE**
Monday 13 February 2012 after 1.00pm.
- 10. PACE OF PLAY**
Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to pairs in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.
- 11. MOTORISED TRANSPORT**
Players must not ride in any form of transportation during a stipulated round unless authorised by the Championship Play Committee. Penalty: 2 strokes for each hole at which a breach occurred; maximum penalty per round – 4 strokes.
Any player or caddie seeking authorisation to use a golf cart due to a disability as defined under the Disability Discrimination Act 1992 should contact Golf Australia to obtain information on procedures for submitting such requests. All such requests and required information must be submitted to Golf Australia simultaneously and together with the entry form (or within 2 days of the on-line entry being receipted). Requests due to temporary injuries or impairments that do not qualify as a permanent disability under the Act will not be granted. In the event of a change in a medical condition after submitting the entry form but before the commencement of the event, written submission of all documentation must be received by Golf Australia no later than 7 days prior to the first day of the event. Golf Australia will consider any such request in accordance with these conditions and its rules, regulations and policies
- 12. GOLF AUSTRALIA HARD CARD**
The Golf Australia Hard Card will be in effect throughout the Australian Men's Foursomes Championship.
Note i: Distance Measuring Devices are NOT permitted. Penalty in accordance with Rule 14-3.
Note ii: The new condition relating to Club Face Grooves will not be in effect until 2014.

RIVERSDALE CUP HISTORY

The "Riversdale Cup" was first played for during an Open Amateur Meeting conducted when the Club was known as "Surrey Hills Golf Club". It was held on the Club's Mont Albert Course between the period 22nd May to 25th May, 1896, and was known then as the "Surrey Hills Gentlemen's Championship, Gold Medal". The Event was continued at Mont Albert until 1907, when the Club moved to Camberwell and changed its name to the "Riversdale Golf Club". Play was not possible in 1908, but the Meeting was recommenced in 1909, and the event then became known as the "Riversdale" Trophy. In 1927, the Club moved to its present St. Johns Wood property, and the Event was resumed on the new Course in 1928 under its present name of the "Riversdale Cup".
